

“Chocolate Soldier” Meets “O’Brien Girl”

*Review of Twentieth Century Musical Stage Hits
 Constitutes “Travelers Hour” for August 29*

Prefaced with the stirring number, “Strike Up the Band” by George Gershwin, the ace of musical comedy composers of 1930, and presenting hits from the musical stage dating back to 1908, when Oskar Straus’ “Chocolate Soldier” was the rage, “The Travelers Hour” for August 29 will be a review of the most popular songs from Broadway shows of the Twentieth Century. The program is booked for Friday night at 9:30 o’clock Eastern Standard Time.

In the absence of Christiaan Kriens, Norman Cloutier, dance orchestra director of Station WTIC, will conduct The Travelers Concert Orchestra. 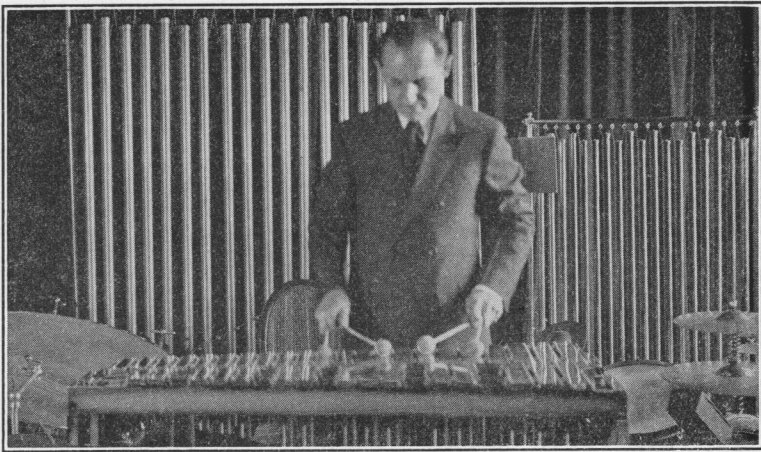
